The Animal Nutrition Association of Canada (ANAC) is the national trade association of the livestock and poultry feed industry. Our 165 members include feed and ingredient manufacturers and distributors, as well as suppliers of a wide range of goods and services to the feed industry. Taken together, ANAC's membership represents 90 percent of commercial feed manufactured in Canada.

Scope of Work

ANAC is seeking an individual to work alongside ANAC staff on a variety of projects throughout the term of this position. These include, but are not limited to:

1. Assisting with the successful delivery of 2021 Animal Nutrition Conference of Canada (ANCC) and work on planning for the 2022 ANCC
2. Working on technical files related to the modernization of the *Feeds Regulations*
3. Implementing and executing ANAC's newly developed communication strategy
4. Developing fact sheets, guidance and training material to help members in their daily work
5. Assisting in the update of the FeedAssure® program

Candidate Requirements

- Must be enrolled in or have graduated within the last year from an undergraduate or graduate program in Animal or Agricultural Science or related field at a Canadian university
- Strong interest in the feed industry and/or animal nutrition with a willingness to learn
- Strong written and oral skills (English is essential, French would be an asset)
- Must be responsible, self-motivated and have good attention to detail
- Able to work independently with minimal supervision and work well in a team
- Computer with Microsoft Office and ability to join video conferences

Compensation

This is a full-time position, 37.5 hours of work per week. The start and finish date will be mutually agreed upon between ANAC and the successful candidate, however the term of this position is approximately 4 months. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the successful candidate will work from home. In

the event the successful candidate is based in the Ottawa area, there might be the ability to work from the office part-time during the summer if it is safe to do so.

Remuneration will be \$20/hour for a total of \$750/week (37.5 hours).
